These Master's programmes cater to the needs of recent graduates looking for an optimal combination of theory and practical hands-on approach either to management or to the highly specialised field of finance, be it from the viewpoint of a business or financial institution. As with all our programmes of study, they are designed to facilitate learning through a variety of teaching methods, technologies and environments.

From the very start of the Master's programmes, students acquire the real-world knowledge, skills and tools crucial to achieving success in their chosen career.

The programmes are provided in a full-time mode over a 12-month period and in a part-time mode over a 24-month period. They are taught by distinguished academic staff of international and national renown with long experience in research and teaching in the areas of Business Management and Finance.

Programme Structure

Each programme consists of 12 taught courses (eight core and four electives) and a Master's dissertation. The elective courses are available from a large selection of subjects. The core courses help students to develop solid management or financial knowledge while the elective courses offer the opportunity to acquire in-depth understanding in specific subject areas and to attain the necessary skills required of successful professionals.

The Master's dissertation helps students to develop strong analytical and writing skills on a subject relating to their studies and career, grounded in academic discipline.

The Timetable

The Master's programmes start in October. Courses are taught over three terms. Examinations and tests take place during these terms. The Master's dissertation is completed over the summer months and is submitted at the end of the third semester.

The MSc in Banking & Finance is designed to equip students for careers in a broad spectrum of financial institutions and industry. The programme addresses issues relating to commercial and investment banking, fund management and corporate finance, international finance and risk management. On completing the course, students will be in a position to pursue careers as analysts, traders, portfolio managers, risk managers, financial consultants or in the financial departments of industrial and service organisations:

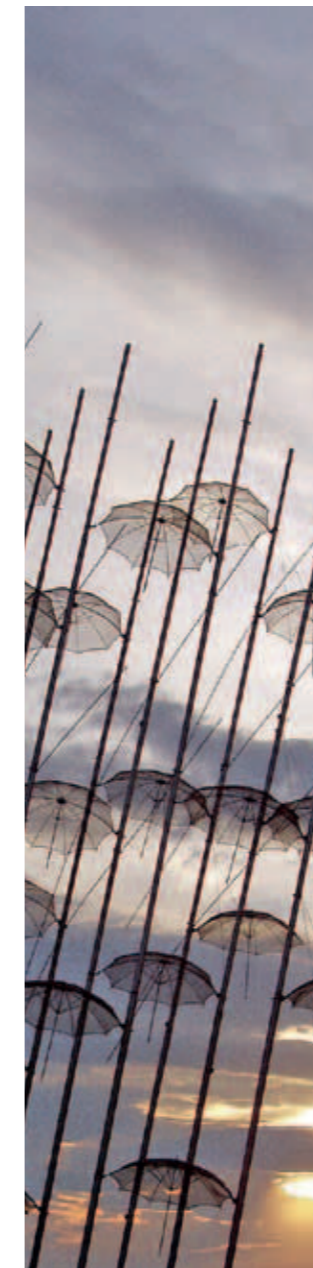
The Elective Modules

The Master's Dissertation

As part of the MSc programme, students work on a 3-month project on a subject relating to their academic interests and career aspirations. The Master's dissertation provides a good opportunity to apply theory and concepts learned in their courses to a real-world business environment. We encourage the completion of dissertations using different types of datasets, writing of case studies and writing reports based on summer internships. The Master's dissertation tests the ability both to apply a certain methodology or approach to analyse a given problem and to demonstrate reasonably original hypotheses.



Admissions While admission to the IHU is competitive, our admissions policy vigorously supports equality of opportunity. We are focused on building a student community which includes men and women from different backgrounds, abilities, economic circumstances, perspectives, races, religions and national origin.

Entry Requirements For your application for an International Hellenic University Master's programme to be considered you need:

- ▶ A good university degree from a recognised university.
- ▶ A good IELTS or TOEFL score or Cambridge Certificate for graduates from non-English-speaking universities.
- ▶ Two academic references (both referees should have direct knowledge of your suitability for the specific Master's programme).
- ▶ Strong motivation and commitment.

When to apply The IHU operates on a rolling admissions basis. This means that candidates apply for and are admitted to our programmes all year round. We suggest, however, that you apply as early as possible to ensure a quick response and place availability. We aim to provide decisions within ten working days of receiving your complete application. Please ensure that you complete the application form fully and submit all your supporting documents for us to make an informed decision.

Scholarships The International Hellenic University offers a number of scholarships for the postgraduate programmes, covering a significant portion of the programme fees. Scholarships are given to top students of proven academic record.
